OCCUPATIONAL DRIVER'S LICENSE CONDITIONS OF SUPERVISION

On [Click here to enter a date.](#), the COURT FINDS the following conditions are necessary to assure the safety of the community while Petitioner is operating a motor vehicle pursuant to an occupational driver's license order issued by this Court, and FURTHER FINDS the Harris County Community Supervision and Corrections Department (HCCS&CD) is authorized by law to supervise defendant.

THE COURT ORDERS Defendant immediately to comply with the following conditions of supervision:

1. PARTICIPATE IN THE ODL SUPERVISION PROGRAM

- 1.1 Participate in the Harris County Community Supervision & Corrections Department ODL Supervision Program HCCS&CD beginning [Click here to enter a date.](#)
- 1.2 Comply with all orders and conditions of the HCCS&CD until [Click here to enter a date.](#), or as otherwise ordered by the court.

2. REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

- 2.1 Report immediately in person to the Court Liaison Officer for Harris County Criminal Court at Law No. _____ on the _____ day of _____, 20_____.
- 2.2 Thereafter to your assigned HCCS&CD Supervision Officer on the _____ of each month thereafter, or as directed by your HCCS&CD Supervision Officer, for the remainder of the supervision term, unless otherwise ordered by the Court.

3. FEES

Pay the following fees through HCCS&CD as specified in this Order with a **money order or cashier's check**. *Personal checks will not be accepted.*

A \$2.00 transaction fee will be charged each time you make a payment.

- 3.1. **IDENTIFICATION CARD.** Pay \$12.50 to HCCS&CD no later than _____ days from the date of this order for an HCCS&CD Identification Card by _____, 20_____
- 3.2. **ADMINISTRATIVE FEE.** Pay an administrative fee at the rate of **Choose an item.** for the duration of your community supervision beginning [Click here to enter a date.](#) to HCCS&CD.
- 3.3. **ADDITIONAL FEES.** Pay any additional fees or costs required by a vendor for the lease, rental or temporary acquisition of a device the court orders you to install and use as set forth herein.

4. DRUG, ALCOHOL POSSESSION OR USE

- 4.1 You are forbidden to use, possess, or consume any controlled substance, dangerous drug, marijuana, alcohol, alcoholic beverages or prescription drug not specifically prescribed to you by lawful prescription.
- 4.2 Provide proof of any medication legally prescribed to you prior to submitting a specimen.

5. RANDOM DRUG AND ALCOHOL TESTING

- 5.1 Submit to random drug/alcohol analysis by authorized personnel of the HCCS&CD.
- 5.2 You are forbidden to ingest, use or consume any substance that will alter, adulterate, dilute or otherwise falsify any urinalysis results.
- 5.3 Pay for each test.

6. ALCOHOL AND DRUG ABUSE ASSESSMENT

Submit to an alcohol/drug evaluation by [Click here to enter a date.](#) and anytime thereafter as directed by your HCCS&CD Supervision Officer.

- 6.1 If treatment is not recommended, Petitioner shall attend the Harris County Alcohol Education Program through the Harris County Community Supervision and Corrections Department, as required by Section 521.245, Texas Transportation Code.

7. ALCOHOL OR DRUG TREATMENT

Participate in an Intensive Outpatient treatment program beginning [Click here to enter a date.](#), followed by Supportive Outpatient alcohol/drug treatment program and at any time thereafter, as directed by your HCCS&CD Supervision Officer.

- 7.1 Attend treatment and aftercare as recommended. Comply with all program rules, regulations and guidelines until successfully discharged or released by further order of the Court.
- 7.2 Pay all fees associated with these services.
- 7.3 On each reporting date, submit written verification of your enrollment, attendance and/or successful completion of the program to your HCCS&CD Supervision Officer.

8. IGNITION INTERLOCK DEVICE

Do not operate a motor vehicle unless it is equipped with a court-approved, camera-equipped deep lung breath analysis mechanism to make impractical the operation of a motor vehicle if alcohol is detected in your breath from:

- a vendor approved by the Texas Department of Public Safety.
- (specify vendor) _____ approved by the Texas Department of Public Safety.

- 8.1 Petitioner shall only operate a motor vehicle equipped with a court-approved, camera equipped deep-lung breath analysis mechanism designed to make impractical the operation of the motor vehicle if ethyl alcohol is detected in Petitioner's breath.
- 8.2 Petitioner shall have the device installed on any vehicle he or she drives within _____ days of the date of the issuance of this occupational license.

- 8.3 IF YOU ARE PROMPTED TO BLOW IN TO THE DEVICE FOR ANY REASON, INCLUDING FOLLOW-UP SAMPLES REQUIRED AS A RESULT OF A WARNING OR A HIGH BAC, YOU MUST BLOW INTO THE DEVICE THREE TIMES AS STATED IN THE INTERLOCK POLICY GUIDELINES
- 8.4 Comply with all required equipment and maintenance service; and
- 8.5 Bear all expense involved in the installation, monthly rental fee, and service of said equipment.
- 8.6 Petitioner may operate a motor vehicle without an ignition interlock if the petitioner is required to operate a motor vehicle in the course and scope of the petitioner's employment, the vehicle is owned, leased by, or registered to petitioner's employer, the employer is not owned or controlled by the petitioner, the employer is notified of the driving privilege restriction and proof of that notification is with the vehicle.

9. AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE

Pursuant to the Texas Motor Vehicle Safety Responsibility Act, you must provide proof of financial responsibility to a peace officer or a HCCS&CD employee upon request.

10. PROHIBITION FROM DRIVING A MOTOR VEHICLE

Do not operate a motor vehicle without a valid Texas driver's license or occupational driver's license.

11. ELECTRONIC MONITORING AND CURFEW

Obtain an electronic monitor and show proof of installation and operation to an HCCS&CD employee no later than [Click here to enter a date.](#)

11.1 Sign and comply with the required contractual agreements required to obtain a monitoring device.
